**EXPLANATION OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE DESIGNATING PORTIONS OF  
STATION ALLEY AND WEST ALLEY AS ONE-WAY STREETS**

**CALL TO ORDER:** A Public Workshop Meeting of the Northampton Borough Council was called to order by President Anthony Lopsonzski, Jr. at 7:15 PM on Thursday, January 21, 2021. The meeting was held virtually via ZOOM and began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Explanation of Proposed Ordinance Designating Portions of Station Alley and West Alley as One-Way Streets**

Solicitor Goudsouzian provided an explanation of the proposed ordinance establishing one-way streets on portions of Station Alley and West Alley. He added that PennDOT has certain signage requirements for the one-way streets.

**Chris Marhefka – 2172 Main Street, Northampton, PA 18067**, asked for clarification on the one-way streets. Mr. Brobst explained that it will be one-way north from 21<sup>st</sup> Street to Station Alley and one-way east from West Alley to Main Street.

Robert McHale added that Planning Commission thought it would be the best option for traffic control to designate West Alley and Station Alley as one-way streets.
