

Eligible for a booster?

Based on [CDC recommendations](#), a booster shot vaccine is [available for certain adults](#) who were fully vaccinated by Pfizer, Moderna, or Janssen.

Individuals who received Moderna or Pfizer vaccine are eligible to get a booster, if:

- It's been at least six months since your initial series of two doses, and you are one of the following:
 - Age 65+
 - Age 18+ and reside in a [long-term care setting](#)
 - Age 18+ and have an [underlying medical condition](#), or
 - Age 18+ and work or live in a [high-risk setting](#).

Individuals who received the Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) vaccine are eligible to get a booster, if:

- It's been at least two months since their initial dose.

**Boosters
are now
available**

If you received **Pfizer or Moderna:**

- **Now** may be the right time to get a booster...
 - If it's been **6 months since your initial series**
 - And you are one of the following:
 - Age **65+**
 - 18+ who live in **long term care settings**
 - 18+ who have **underlying medical condition**
 - 18+ who work or live in **high-risk settings**

If you received **Janssen (J&J):**

- **Now** may be the right time to get a booster if you are 18+ and it's been **2 months since your first dose**

Regardless of the brand of your primary series, you may get any brand of booster
